Good Day,

As previously communicated, African Content Movement (ACM) would like to formally request an opportunity to make oral submission to the Inquiry led by former deputy Chief Justice Dikgang Moseneke.

Our view as movement is that the interest of the people must determine the suitability to hold any elections. Our fundamental position is that medical experts/scientists must advise all of us including the inquiry, government, civil society and political parties.

As political parties, we have vested interests, and our views must be seen from that angle. We must be guided by medical scientists. We do not support a view that suggests politicians or party political considerations are more important than the lives of the people.

Equally, we believe in the leadership of Justice Dikgang Moseneke as a constitutional being, and do not doubt his ability to guide us on matters concerning protecting the constitution. The constitution cannot be above the need to secure lives.

We must rise above party ideological differences and allow the medical scientific data to lead our deliberations.
